# **Sharing PENCIL Content**

**STEP ONE:** Log into your LinkedIn account and search **PENCIL** in the bar at the top of the page. Select PENCIL's "Company" page.



While you're there, follow PENCIL's page (if you're not already).



## STEP TWO: Scroll down to find a post you want to share and click "Like" at the bottom of it.



#### STEP THREE: Click Share.
