Event Goals: PENCIL's Back to School Breakfast fundraiser raises financial and community support for

level, and with your help, we can do that!

Table Host Responsibilities: Strategically invite <u>seven</u> guests to sit at your table, who are strong prospects to connect with and invest in PENCIL; and take the time leading up to the event to have meaningful conversations with your guests about PENCIL's mission, programs, and achievements.

Before the event

- Make a list of potential guests who will likely connect with and invest in PENCIL. Think about inviting members of a club or group you are part of to be your guests make it your August meeting.
- Secure commitments from **seven people**, **in addition to yourself**, to attend the event
- Track your guest names and emails under your table information on the <u>BTSB website</u> (one.bidpal.net/BTSB23) no later than Friday, August 11.
- During the **week of August 14**, call or email your guests to remind them of the event and share the names of other guests who will be joining. *PENCIL will provide you with additional tools to assist with pre-event communication.*

Event day

- **Arrive early** to greet your table guests.
- Help guide conversations around PENCIL's mission and manage the giving moment at your table(s). *More information will be provided prior to the event.*
- Make your own personal/company gift at the same time your guests pledge their support.

After the event

• **Follow up with a personal email or handwritten note of thanks** to your guests. *PENCIL will provide you with a list of your table guests and their investment.*

Frequently Asked Questions

Is there a virtual option this year?

No. Though if a guest cannot attend and would like to learn more about PENCIL, a PENCIL staff person would be happy to meet with them individually.

What if I have more or less than seven guests?

If you have more than seven guests, you can host an additional table or add individual guests to your group at one.bidpal.net/BTSB23. If you have fewer than seven guests, please let us know so we can fill the vacancies with other interested parties.

What if my guests change after August 4?

Is there a fundraising expectation?

Where does the money go?
