CORE ISSUE ADDRESSED:

Population-level barriers that keep students from reaching their unique potential, from literacy and numeracy to social-emotional learning, teen sexual health, integrating international families, and more.



WHAT DOES ALIGNMENT NASHVILLE DO?

Alignment Nashville acts as an "initiative incubator," connecting MNPS to the talent and expertise of Nashville's business, healthcare, and nonprofit sectors to create game-changing initiatives that will build generations of thriving young Nashvillians.

HOW ALIGNMENT NASHVILLE WORKS:

Brings community experts and MNPS leaders together to identify societal challenges that affect student success (Explore Teams), engages community experts to strategize around those issues (Change Teams), and supports viable action plans to address those issues (Sustain Teams).

WHAT DOES PENCIL DO?

PENCIL partners with businesses, community groups, and other organizations to bridge the resource gaps in MNPS that directly impact day-to-day learning in classrooms.


HOW PENCIL WORKS.

Recruits and matches volunteers to serve as tutors within classrooms; pairs professionals with students for career exploration and mentorship; collects and distributes essential school supplies; operates Family Resource Centers within schools; coordinates all volunteer background check services for MNPS.

WHAT IS ACHIEVED AS A RESULT?

Students engage with and learn from community members; schools and students benefit from long-term community relationships; all schools have the core supplies their teachers and students need; barriers to student attendance are removed.
